# Sermon Reflection Sheet: Fearless Finances – "Fearless Generosity"

### Luke 6:35-38

- The context for this passage is Jesus' teaching on loving your enemies.
- Consider the eternal elements of generosity. It cannot just be something we know we should exhibit; it is more than that.
- Reflect on what God has done for you and given to you.
- Generosity is the response to what God has done for you; it is not optional.

## Sowing and Reaping

- Consider what you are sowing and if your manner of life is pleasing to God.
- Ask yourself these questions, which am I more inclined towards, judgement or love? Condemnation or love? Empathy or discernment?
- Reflect on ways you need to temper your judgement and increase in love.
- Reflect on ways you need to grow in discernment and godly judgement.

## **Thinking Practically**

- Reflect on a biblical understanding of what it means to be blessed.
- Ask yourself the question, do my finances and stance towards generosity reflect my submission to the Lord?
- Examine your current priorities with your finances and be open to restructuring them according to God's desires for your life.
- Consider what amount of generosity the Lord is asking you to participate in.

## **Prayer Points:**

- Ask the Lord to help you reflect your Heavenly Father in generosity.
- Thank God for His great mercy and grace towards you even when you were distant from Him.
- Ask for the Lord to help you grow in love and godly judgement.
- Thank God for what He has given to you and ask Him to provide more opportunities to be generous.
