Title: Faithful Stewardship in Fearful Times

Matthew 25:14-30

- 1. The Lord gives us gifts. (v. 14-18)
 - a. We must understand that everything belongs to God. James 1:17 says, "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."
 - b. We need to understand that God knows us so well, he knows what and how much we can be entrusted with. So, he gives it to us accordingly.
- 2. The Lord holds us accountable (vv. 19-27)
- 3. The Lord judges us (vv. 28-30)

Today's bottom line is:

The Lord blesses us with all that we need to faithfully follow Him until He returns.

Now a couple of questions to chew on

- 1. Consider the gifts that God has blessed you with. Possessions, people, finances, talents. Take some time this week and THANK HIM for those gifts.
- 2. Ask yourself, how are you managing those gifts?
- 3. Are you generous and sacrificial?
- 4. Are you a good manager?
- 5. Are you investing in Gods Kingdom or your own kingdom?
- 6. If you find you haven't been a faithful servant with these resources, don't live in despair. Live with determination to be led by the Holy Spirit in faithfulness.
